Along with the continued, faithful support of the congregation, we would like to acknowledge two external financial sources of support to the food pantry ministry. We received a grant of \$1600 from ShopRite, which will be administered monthly to obtain additional food items from Fulfill (formerly the Ocean and Monmouth County Food Bank). Also, once again, we have received a very generous, anonymous, donation of \$1200 in Stop & Shop cards.

UMCOR SUNDAY

(Formerly One Great Hour of Sharing)

Sunday, March 11, 2018

The United Methodist Committee on Relief (UMCOR) is the not-for-profit humanitarian agency of The United Methodist Church. Since 1940 UMCOR's mission — providing relief in disaster areas, aiding refugees and confronting the challenge of world hunger and poverty — has helped to heal the hurts of humanity in nearly 100 countries.

United Methodists assist UMCOR through gifts collected on UMCOR Sunday, which is observed on the fourth Sunday in Lent. This church wide Special Sunday calls United Methodists to share the goodness of life with those who hurt. Monies collected underwrite UMCOR's "costs of doing business." This helps UMCOR keep its promise that every gift to a specific UMCOR project will go toward that project, not for administrative costs.

DeBows UMC will participate in UMCOR Sunday on March 11, 2018. Special offering envelopes will be available in the pews to support this UMC ministry.

Box Tops for Education

We continue to collect Box Tops for Education to support The *Red Bird Missionary Conference*. They will be able to use these box tops to purchase needed items for the school they run (pre-school to high school). A collection jar and a list of products that carry these box tops are available on the table outside of Fellowship Hall.

Greeting Cards for St. Jude's

This mission, based on recycling old greeting cards, supports St. Jude's entrepreneurial teen-run job training program. What are you doing with the greeting cards you received for Christmas? *Only the front of the card is used*, so any donated cards must not have writing on the back of the front picture. Please note: they do not accept Hallmark, Disney or American Greeting Cards. There is a collection box outside of Fellowship Hall.

UMCOR Hygiene Kits

For these grocery cards, we realize a higher percentage rebate than with Scrip and turn around time is much less.


